Within FFA, members can compete in various different contests. The first one Evergreen FFA will be participating in is Soil Judging. Ohio FFA recognizes two types of soil judging, Rural & Urban.

Rural

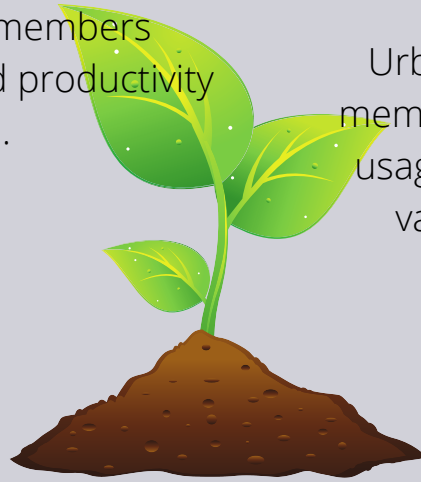
Rural Soil Judging is where members evaluate land for the usage and productivity for crop production.



Any member is welcomed and encouraged to participate in the county soil judging contest where you will pick either Rural or Urban to compete in. The top 8 individuals in each division will then move onto the district contest. County contest is September 22nd.

Urban

Urban Soil Judging is where members evaluate land for the usage of building homes and various other buildings.
