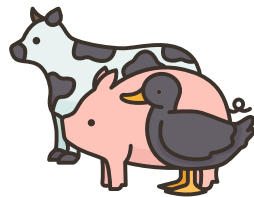

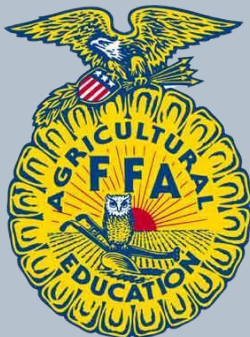


Evergreen FFA Spring Banquet
